Location

The land is situated to the west of Idle Bank to the south east of Wroot and to the west of Westwoodside.

Description

The land comprises a regularly shaped arable field situated off Idle Bank, accessed via a bridge over South Idle Drain.

The land is classified as being Grade 2 on Sheet 103 of the Provisional Agricultural Land Classification Maps as historically published by the Ministry of Agriculture Fisheries and Food.

The soils are identified by the Soil Survey of England and Wales as being predominantly from the "Isleham 2" association with their characteristics described as "deep permeable sandy and peaty soils" and as suitable for "cereals, sugar beet, potatoes and horticultural crops".

Basic Payment Scheme

The land is registered on the Rural Payments Agency Rural Land register and has been used to activate Basic Payment Scheme entitlements by the farming Tenant. The 2022 claim is reserved in it's entirety to them.
